

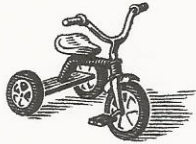


LEARN TO PLAY BRIDGE!



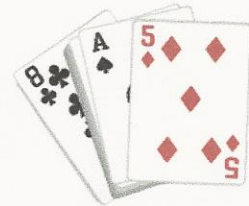
BUILD SKILLS! HAVE FUN!

MiniBridge 1



A trick-taking mind sport for four players (“dynamic brain training”) played as partners --Attackers (Boss & Puppet) vs. Defenders. Precursor to learning bridge for all ages – effective & enjoyable. Start playing right away without having to know rules for bidding or scoring. Focus on card basics, bridge etiquette, hand evaluation, playing to win tricks, defending, and simplified scoring. Begin a solid foundation of skills to build upon.

MiniBridge 2



Prerequisite: MiniBridge 1 or equivalent. Take skills learned in MiniBridge 1 and add full MiniBridge scoring plus strategies to decide Target goal (part score or game number of tricks for bonus points) and to play the hand to create more tricks as well as strategies to defend. Everything you learn in MiniBridge is relevant to “real” bridge, i.e. counting your points, how to play the cards, game and part score contracts, scoring, etc.

Beginning Bridge 1



Prerequisite: MiniBridge 2 or equivalent. Objective: continue to build a solid foundation of basic bridge skills used in the Standard American Bridge System that will let the player play with different people including online. Take skills learned in MiniBridge and begin to add basic bidding skills as well as continue to practice playing. The ACBL book, Bidding in the 21st Century, will be used.
